We kindly invite you to take part to this scientific event or, if it is not possible, at least one of the scholars of the academic body of your university. The papers must fit to the subsequent **topics**:

- *The Diaspora and the Mission of the Church;*
- *Contemporary Monasticism and the Mission of the Church;*
- *The Mission of the Church and Social Work;*
- *Media and the Mission of the Church;*

In order to be presented at the conference, all selected works will be reviewed by the scientific committee. The papers must be original works, written in a good English with considerable scientific relevance and must not be published previous elsewhere.

### **Registration, accommodation & expenses:**

The registration form and the abstract of your paper must be submitted to rev. Dumitru A. VANCA ([vancadum@yahoo.com](mailto:vancadum@yahoo.com)). Please retain, until **March, 28**, we need the title and the abstract of your presentation (up to 300 words), 4-5 keywords.

The organisers will cover the expenses for the accommodation & meals, reception and coffee breaks, the conference documents, the conference book.

### **Publishing:**

Your full paper must be submitted as an email attachment to rev. Dumitru A. VANCA ([vancadum@yahoo.com](mailto:vancadum@yahoo.com)), until **April, 17**. The texts must be prepared in English (UK) as MS Word document, using font 12 Times New Roman, single spacing.

- The conference volume is published as special issue of the *Altarul Reîntregirii Journal* (CEEOL database). Please note, that studies should not exceed 8,000 words (including notes, remarks, abstract and references); they also must include the author's name, affiliation, an English abstract and 4-5 keywords. Please attach also a small presentation of you which may include scientific and academic titles and ranks, a relevant work and your e-mail. We recommend to include a running title of maximum 70 characters (including spaces), if your original title exceed this. The studies containing ancient Greek, Hebrew or Slavonic characters must be accompanied by fonts used.

- A selection of the presented papers will be published as extended works in The *International Journal of Orthodox Theology* (Germany, ATLA database). The selected studies must be prepared according to the rules, procedures, terms and conditions for publication of IJOTh, available at the journal website (<http://www.orthodox-theology.com>). For improving your work, it is also possible to be asked by the IJOTh editors to review some parts of your work.


**Working languages:**
